

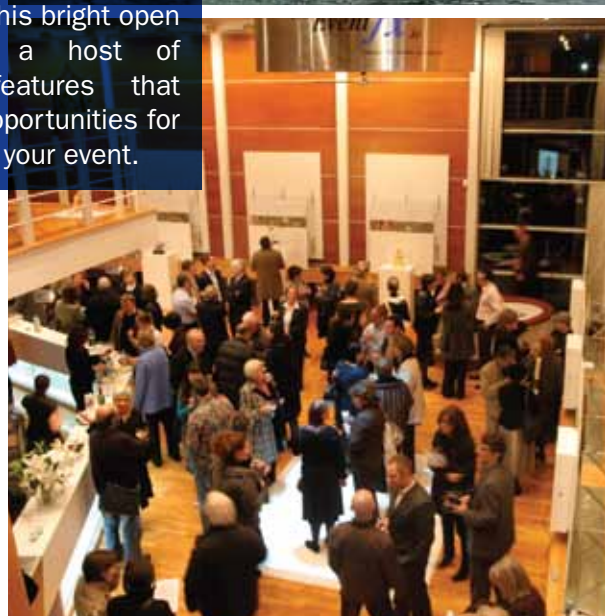
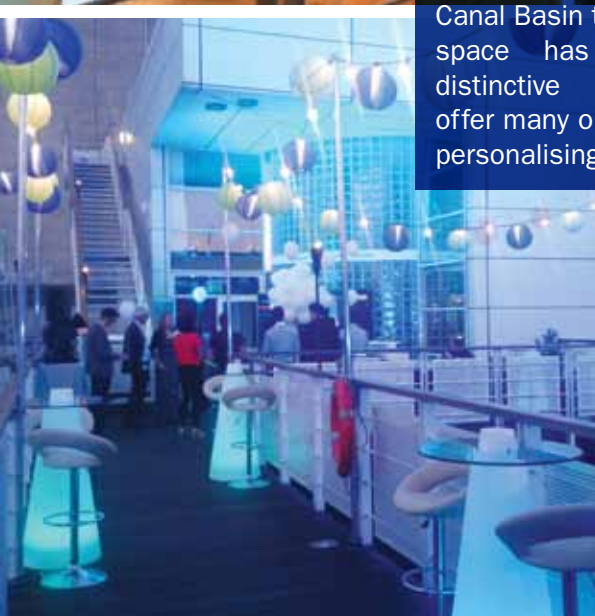


# Waterways Ireland Centre

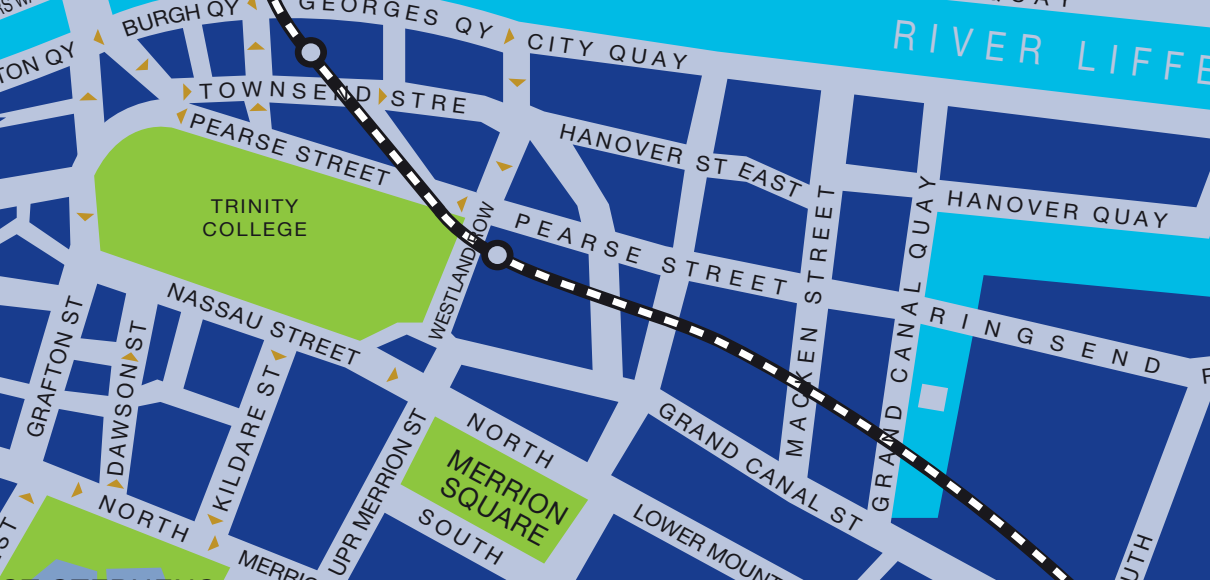
